

MINI MUSICIANS

Mini Musicians is the perfect introduction to music lessons for your child. This is a no-pressure, no-practice curriculum where we explore music and the piano through improvisation, songs and games.

Our Mini Musicians learn to explore sounds, listen actively and move to music. They also get introduced to the piano keys, develop reading skills and learn about rhythm notation. Then, in the second year, they begin to play more pattern based improvisations and learn to play songs on the piano together.

You do not need a piano at home for your child to take part in Mini Musicians but it is beneficial to have instruments for them to experiment on - this could be bells, a tambourine, a glockenspiel or a toy keyboard.

Our Mini Musicians will not have practice assignments but will benefit from trying the fingerplay rhymes and listening to music we're covering in class between lessons.

Structure of the Class

- Mini Musicians is a weekly 60-minute class.
- Groups are kept small, just 6-8 students, so your child will get the individual attention they need to thrive.
- Each weekly class involves singing, moving, improvising and learning about music through games.
- Parents normally do not stay for this class (kids often find their own parents a bit distracting!) but are welcome to sit in whenever they want - some students may need this in the first few weeks to ease the transition.
